M.R.18878 - In re: Andrea E. Gambino. Disciplinary Commission.

The petition by the Administrator of the Attorney Registration and Disciplinary Commission to impose discipline on consent pursuant to Supreme Court Rule 762(b) is allowed. Respondent Andrea E. Gambino is suspended from the practice of law for one (1) year, with the suspension stayed after ninety (90) days by a one (1)-year period of probation subject to the following conditions:

a. Respondent shall attend meetings scheduled by the Commission probation officer as requested by the Administrator;

b. Respondent shall notify the Administrator within fourteen days of any change of address;

c. Respondent shall comply with the Illinois Rules of Professional Conduct and shall timely cooperate with the Administrator in providing information regarding any investigations;

d. Respondent shall reimburse the Commission for the costs of this proceeding as defined in Supreme Court Rule 773 and shall reimburse the Commission for any further costs incurred during the period of probation;

e. Respondent shall remain in treatment with Dr. Marion Page, or another mental health professional acceptable to the Administrator, for the entire period of probation. Respondent shall comply with all treatment recommendations of Dr. Page or any other treating professional. Respondent shall notify the Commission within fourteen days of the name and address of any substitute treating professional. Respondent shall execute an appropriate confidentiality release to allow Dr. Page, or any other treating professional, to provide quarterly reports to the Administrator regarding respondent's participation in and progress with her treatment, and Dr. Page or any substitute treating professional shall provide such reports to the Commission; and

f. Probation shall be revoked if respondent is found to have violated any of the terms of probation. The remaining period of suspension shall commence from the date of the determination that any term of probation has been violated.

Respondent Andrea E. Gambino shall reimburse the Disciplinary Fund for any Client Protection payments arising from her conduct prior to the termination of the period of suspension/probation.

The motion by respondent to commence discipline on January 1, 2004, is allowed.
