### Order

The Supreme Court having determined that the public necessity so requires:

Effective February 1, 2013, and terminating December 1, 2014, the Honorable Sheldon A. Harris, Judge of the Circuit Court of Cook County, is reassigned to duty in the Appellate Court of Illinois, First Judicial District, to the vacancy created by the retirement of the Honorable John O. Steele. Judge Harris shall retain his current rotation in the Second Division and continue with his current case assignments.

During such service on the Appellate Court, Judge Harris is relieved from all his regular duties in the Circuit Court of Cook County, and he shall receive compensation for such active service at the rate normally paid Appellate Judges of the State of Illinois.
