M.R.027370 - In re: Thomas R. Cirignani. Disciplinary Commission.

Motion by petitioner Thomas R. Cirignani to strike the Administrator's proposed additional modified conditions. Denied.

Motion by the Administrator of the Attorney Registration and Disciplinary Commission to approve and confirm the report and recommendation of the Hearing Board with modifications. Allowed. The petition of Thomas R. Cirignani for reinstatement to the roll of attorneys licensed to practice law in Illinois pursuant to Supreme Court Rule 767 is allowed subject to the following conditions, which shall be applicable during the first two (2) years following reinstatement:

- a. Petitioner shall comply with Article VII of the Illinois Supreme Court Rules on Admission and Discipline of Attorneys and the Illinois Rules of Professional Conduct and shall timely cooperate with the Administrator in providing information regarding any investigation relating to his conduct;
- b. Petitioner, upon reinstatement, shall comply with the Minimum Continuing Legal Education requirements for reinstated attorneys set out in Supreme Court Rule 791(f);
- c. Petitioner shall attend meetings as scheduled by the Commission probation officer. Petitioner shall submit quarterly written reports to the commission probation officer concerning the status of his practice of law and the nature and extent of his compliance with the conditions of his reinstatement;

- d. Petitioner shall notify the Administrator within fourteen (14) days of any change of address;
- e. Petitioner shall abstain from the usage of any unprescribed controlled substances and alcohol. Petitioner shall report to the Administrator any lapse in his sobriety or usage of any unprescribed controlled substances within seventy-two (72) hours of that usage;
- f. Petitioner shall, as required by the Administrator, submit to random substance testing by a qualified mental health professional or facility approved by the Administrator, within eight (8) hours of receiving notice by the Administrator that he shall submit to the testing. The results of the tests shall be reported to the Administrator. Petitioner shall pay any and all costs of such testing;
- g. Petitioner shall participate in a 12-step program such as Alcoholics Anonymous by attending at least two meetings per week. Petitioner is to maintain a log of his attendance at the meetings and submit it to the Administrator with his quarterly reports;
- h. Petitioner shall maintain a sponsor in the 12-step program and shall provide the name, address and telephone number of the sponsor to the Administrator within fourteen (14) days of entry of the Court's final order. Petitioner shall request that the sponsor communicate with the Administrator in writing on a quarterly basis regarding petitioner's participation and progress in the 12-step program and report any lapses in sobriety or usage of unprescribed controlled substances to the Administrator within seventy-two (72) hours of his knowledge of that usage;

- i. Within sixty (60) days of his reinstatement, petitioner shall engage in a course of treatment with a psychotherapist approved by the Administrator and shall comply with treatment recommendations by the therapist. Petitioner shall authorize the psychotherapist to provide a report in writing to the Administrator no less than every three (3) months regarding petitioner's progress and compliance with treatment recommendations;
- j. Within sixty (60) days of his reinstatement, petitioner shall submit to an evaluation by an appropriate mental health professional approved by the Administrator for the purpose of assessing his diagnosis of attention deficit disorder and depression. Petitioner shall authorize the mental health professional to provide a report in writing to the Administrator and to Dr. Rad Gharavi, or other psychiatrist approved by the Administrator, with whom the mental health professional shall work to determine the appropriate medications for those disorders;
- k. Petitioner shall continue with his treatment by Dr. Rad Gharavi, or other psychiatrist approved by the Administrator, for the purpose of medication management. After the completion of the evaluation outlined in sub-paragraph "j", above, Dr. Gharavi, or other psychiatrist approved by the Administrator, shall cooperate with the mental health professional in determining the appropriate medications for petitioner's disorders. Petitioner shall authorize Dr. Gharavi or other treater to provide a report in writing to the Administrator no less than every three (3) months, regarding the petitioner's medication management; and
- l. Petitioner's conditional reinstatement shall be revoked if petitioner is found to have violated any of the conditions of his reinstatement described in sub-paragraphs "a" through "k" above, and petitioner shall be suspended

from the practice of law until further order of the Court.

- b. Respondent shall reimburse the Commission for the costs of this proceeding as defined in Supreme Court Rule 773 and, at least thirty (30) days prior to the termination of the period of probation, shall reimburse the Commission for any further costs incurred during the period of probation;
- c. At least thirty (30) days prior to the termination of the period of probation, respondent shall reimburse the Client Protection Program Trust Fund for any Client Protection payments arising from his conduct;
- d. Respondent shall notify the Administrator within seven (7) days of any arrest or charge alleging his violation of any criminal or quasi-criminal statute or ordinance;
- e. Respondent shall attend meetings as scheduled by the Commission probation officer. Respondent shall submit quarterly written reports to the Commission probation officer concerning the status of his practice of law and the nature and extent of his compliance with the conditions of probation;
- f. Respondent shall notify the Administrator within fourteen (14) days of any change of address;
- g. Respondent shall establish and utilize a system for the handling of funds belonging to clients and third parties that conforms to the requirements of Rule 1.15 of the Illinois Rules of Professional Conduct and instructions provided to respondent by the Administrator, including the following Trust Account Procedures:

Basic accounting records that must be maintained daily and accurately:

Account Check Register – list sequentially all trust account deposits and trust account disbursements and maintain a current and accurate daily balance on the trust account;

Account Receipts Journal – list chronologically all deposits into the trust account, each deposit to list the date of the deposit, the source of each deposit, the client matter, the deposit number and the amount of the deposit. Maintain a copy of each item deposited;

Client Ledger Journal – list chronologically for each client matter all receipts, disbursements and remaining balances, preparing a separate page for each client matter and listing chronologically all receipts and disbursements and remaining balances for each client matter; and

Reconciliation reports – maintain a running balance for all ledgers and account books. The balances in the client ledger journal must be reconciled each month with the balances in the receipt and disbursement journals, the account checkbook register and the bank statements. Copies of each reconciliation report and supporting records and journals, demonstrating respondent's compliance with Rule 1.15, shall be provided to the Administrator quarterly;

Source documents which must be preserved for seven (7) years:

Bank statements;

Deposit slips;

Cancelled checks – all trust account checks must have a named payee (no checks written to "cash") and the memo portion of the check must contain a reference to a client matter;

Reconciliation reports and records;

Time and billing records; and

Copies of records from client files that are necessary for a full understanding of the lawyer's financial transactions with the client: e.g., retainer and engagement agreements; settlement statements to clients showing the disbursement of the settlement proceeds; bills sent to clients and records of payments to other lawyers or non-employees for services rendered;

- h. Respondent shall abstain from the usage of alcohol and any unprescribed controlled substances;
- i. Respondent shall continue in his course of aftercare treatment with Presence Health, or such other qualified mental health agency or professional acceptable to the Administrator, and shall report to Presence Health, or such other qualified mental health agency or professional on a regular basis of not less than once per week, with the Administrator advised of any change in attendance deemed warranted by such professional;
- j. Respondent shall comply with all treatment recommendations of Dr. Henry Conroe and Presence Health or such other qualified mental health agency or professional, including the taking of medications as prescribed;
- k. Respondent shall provide to Presence Health, or such other qualified agency or mental health professional, an appropriate release authorizing the treating professional(s) to: (1) disclose to the Administrator on at least a quarterly basis information pertaining to the nature of respondent's compliance with any treatment plan established with respect to respondent's condition; (2) promptly report to the Administrator respondent's failure to

comply with any part of an established treatment plan; and (3) respond to any inquiries by the Administrator regarding respondent's mental or emotional state or compliance with any established treatment plans;

- I. Respondent shall notify the Administrator within fourteen (14) days of any change in treatment professionals;

- m. Respondent shall, as required by the Administrator, submit to random substance testing by a qualified mental health professional or facility approved by the Administrator, within eight (8) hours of receiving notice by the Administrator to submit to the testing or with daily breath testing with an Administrator approved testing device. The results of the test shall be reported to the Administrator. Respondent shall pay any and all costs of such testing;

- n. Respondent shall participate in Alcoholics Anonymous and/or the Lawyers' Assistance Program, by attending at least two (2) meetings a week. Respondent is to maintain a log of his attendance at the meetings and submit it to the Administrator with his quarterly reports;

- o. Respondent shall maintain a sponsor in the 12-step program and shall provide the name, address, telephone number, and email address of the sponsor to the Administrator within fourteen (14) days of being placed on probation. Respondent shall request that the sponsor, or the Lawyers' Assistance Program if respondent has obtained the sponsor through LAP, communicate with the Administrator in writing on a quarterly basis regarding respondent's participation and progress in the 12-step program and report any lapses in sobriety or usage of

unprescribed controlled substances to the Administrator within seventy-two (72) hours of his/her knowledge of that usage;

- p. Respondent shall report to the Administrator any lapse in his sobriety or usage of any unprescribed controlled substances within seventy-two (72) hours of that usage;
- q. Probation shall be revoked if respondent is found to have violated any of the terms of probation. The remaining nineteen (19) month period of suspension shall commence from the date of the determination that any term of probation has been violated and shall continue until further order of the Court; and
- r. Probation shall terminate without further order of court provided that respondent complies with the above conditions.
