ORDER

It appearing to the Court that a verified petition has been filed by the Administrator of the Attorney Registration and Disciplinary Commission alleging that you should be suspended from the practice of law, effective immediately, and until further order of Court pursuant to Supreme Court Rule 774, and restrained from taking the oath or assuming office as a circuit court judge, in light of the allegations of the verified petition filed by the Administrator of the Attorney Registration and Disciplinary Commission that a complaint has been voted against you by the Inquiry Board; that you violated the Rules of Professional Conduct; that your conduct involves fraud or moral turpitude or threatens irreparable injury to the public, your clients, or the orderly administration of justice; and that there appears to be persuasive evidence to support the charges indicated in the complaint filed against you in *In re: Rhonda Crawford*, 2016PR00115; and seeking your interim suspension from the practice of law until further order of the Court pursuant to Supreme Court Rule 774;

Now, therefore, the said respondent Rhonda Crawford is hereby ruled to show cause, in writing, why she should not be suspended from the practice of law effective immediately and until further order of the Court pursuant to Supreme Court Rule 774.

The answer to this rule shall be filed in the office of the Clerk of this Court in Springfield on or before October 28, 2016.
